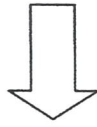
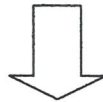


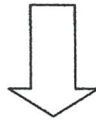
## Gluten Free Food Service- For diagnosed celiac patients



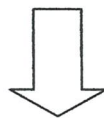
Doctor diagnoses through tests and gives patient a referral form (part 1 is filled out by GP) which the patient takes to a pharmacy of their choice.



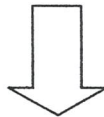
Pharmacist explains rules of the service and answers any questions about the patient's condition. The pharmacist fills out the 2<sup>nd</sup> part of the referral form and keeps this in the pharmacy.



Pharmacist completes PCR for patient including their CHI number and calculates their allowance.



Patient receives an order form and requests GF food which the pharmacist writes a CP(us) form for and orders in.



Review patient's needs yearly and update PCR – refer back to GP if anything changes

### Notes:

- If patient wishes to come off pharmacy service then refer back to GP to be managed.
- If patient wishes to change pharmacy then refer back to GP to get new referral form
- If age/pregnancy status changes then increase or decrease allowance of units
